Objective: create a map with key geographic features identified and labeled

**Directions:** Label the following geographic features on your world maps. You will label on two different maps; pay careful attention to which map you are supposed to use. Use the atlases provided (p. 10-11) OR the atlases in your textbook (A4-A5) to help you locate the features.

## **USE MAP A: POLITICAL MAP**

- 1. **7 continents**: Europe, North America, South America, Africa, Asia, Australia, Antarctica (label in red)
- 2. **Orientation: Draw** a compass rose on your map-include cardinal directions (N, S, E, W) and intermediate directions (NE, SE, SW, NW)
- 3. **Other Features:** Equator, Prime Meridian, Tropic of Cancer, Tropic of Capricorn (trace these and **label** them clearly in black ink) and the Northern, Southern, Eastern, Western Hemispheres (you can **label** these on your map **OR draw** a diagram on the bottom)
- 4. **Define:** Equator, Prime Meridian, Tropic of Cancer & Tropic of Capricorn (you may have do these definitions on a separate sheet of paper or the bottom/back of this)

## **USE MAP B: PHYSICAL MAP**

- 1. **5 oceans**: Pacific, Atlantic, Arctic, Southern, Indian (label in blue)
- 2. **Seas**: Mediterranean, Caribbean Sea, Gulf of Mexico, Red Sea, Black Sea, Adriatic Sea (**label** in purple)
- 3. **Mountains**: Ural, Alps, Himalayas, Andes, Rockies, Appalachian ( label & **draw** brown ▲)
- 4. **Deserts**: Sahara, Arabian, Kalahari, Gobi (label, **outline and shade** in orange)
- 5. **Rivers**: Amazon, Nile, Mississippi (**label & trace** in blue)
